REGIONAL EVENTS IN SOUTH-EAST

Swingfield Church – 13 April at 2.00pm

All Saints' Church is currently undergoing extensive repair and conservation works before it is taken into Trust by the Churches Conservation Trust. This work includes extensive masonry repairs to the Tower and timber repairs to the mediaeval roof structure. The Trust have invited members to visit during the open day, when the contractor and architect will show members around. Members can attend any time between 10.00am and 3.30pm but it would be nice if EASA members could attend at 2.00pm to meet other members. There is no charge on the day, but a contribution to CCT funds would be appreciated.

Dunstable Church – 15 April 2.00pm to 4.30pm

This event is in collaboration with the Diocese of Guildford at St Mary and All Saints' Church, the finest 13th century church in Surrey. There will be short presentations by Reverend Ruth Walker, Secretary to the Guildford DAC, the architect, Mr John Deal, on the installation and practicalities of the trench arch drainage system and Mr Robert Jones of Mountfield Ecology on working with bats in churches. There is a minimal charge of £7.50 per person.

Lympne Church – 22 July at 2.00pm

St Stephen's Church is an outstanding mediaeval building with good Norman and 13th century fabric. Under the direction of member, Robert George, the PCC have installed an underfloor heating system with bore holes. This geothermal heating installation has now been running for over a year. Members are invited to visit to discuss and see the installation with Robert and the firm who carried out the installation. We also hope to have a short presentation from the Diocese of Canterbury on matters they wish to bring to architects' attention. There is a minimal charge of £7.50 per person to cover administration costs and a donation to the church.

Guildford – 17 September at 10.30am

The SPAB are holding a full day visit to Guildford, visiting St Mary's Church, Holy Trinity Church and the Cathedral, under the direction of John Bailey, the architect for all three buildings. St Mary's Church has a 10th century central tower and outstanding fabric from the 11th to 15th centuries. Holy Trinity Church was completed in 1763 to the designs of James Horne, and altered by Henry Woodyer in 1869 and Blomfield in 1888. Guildford Cathedral was designed by the architect, Sir Edward Maufe, and was constructed between 1936 and 1965/66 of concrete and brick. Members will also be able to visit the tower and crypt areas.
